Bakari was born into an activist family. His father, civil rights leader Cleveland Sellers, instilled core values in him to continue in the tireless commitment to service.

In 2005 Bakari earned a bachelor's degree in African-American Studies from Morehouse College. He earned his juris doctor at University of South Carolina School of Law in 2008. Bakari currently practices law with the Strom Law Firm, LLC in Columbia, SC where he heads the firm's Strategic Communication and Public Affairs team and has recently added Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Consulting to the list of services offered.

Bakari made history in the 2006 South Carolina state legislature as the youngest African American elected official in the nation, age 22. In 2014 he was the Democratic Nominee for Lt. Governor in the state of South Carolina. Bakari worked for US Congressman James Clyburn and former Atlanta Mayor Shirley Franklin.
